## **Ongoing Business & Committee Updates**

- VDV Book Fair:
  - Best book fair yet!
  - \$16,762 in gross sales
  - \$1,249 from Share the Fair
  - \$144 spent on Vandercart
  - \$1,790 spent for teacher and student wishlists
  - \$7,075 earned
  - Literacy Night was a huge success and helped a lot with the sales of the fair
- 2024 Grant Program:
  - VDV had 3 approved grants
    - Kessler for \$80 for flexible seating
    - Lanouette for \$109.40 for flexible seating
    - Clark/Durso for approximately \$1,330.48 for Mindfulness in the Classroom tools
    - Total is \$1,519.88 for VDV spent with approximately \$1,980.12 left over
